SUI	ACC	When will we have more detailed information about the accommodation solutions in the mountains?	We are working to define and establish all aspects of this matter. Rest assured, you will receive comprehensive information in the near future. Our team is continuing to work on finalizing all details.
JPN	AND	Airport transport: Any support for teams arriving in Milano Malpensa to move to Torino and mountain clusters? In Lake Placid 2023, there was Rate Card Buses that teams could book and paid for the services, that was helpful.	The official points of entry will be Torino Caselle Airport and Torino train station Porta Susa. Torino Airport serves as a hub for international and European flights, offering a wide range of airline options. Additionally, local European carriers provide service to Torino Airport, making it a convenient choice for travelers. We recommend considering Torino Airport for its connectivity with major international hubs and competitive pricing compared to flights to Milano. There will be no official transport service from Milano Malpensa. However, if a delegation chooses to travel to Malpensa, we will provide assistance by indicating transport service providers that can be contacted directly by the delegations, such as the Rate Card buses of Lake Placid.
SUI	TRA	Thank you. Is there a transport solution between Bardonecchia and Sestrière, without going through Torino?	The mobility plan insists on sustainability pillars and usage of existing public transportation network to connect Turin city with mountain clusters. The only mountain cluster not connected by train is Pragelato-Sestriere and therefore a TC service will be implemented for all stakeholders on
JPN	TRA	Any plan of Inter-Village transport between Bardonecchia and Sestriere? Ski team may share some resources between those two areas and need to move between 2 clusters.	a daily base. There is no planned OC transport services between the mountain clusters themselves (i.e. Bardonecchia <> Sestriere). This is mainly due to limited demand and significant distances between clusters. Delegations are encouraged to either use the Self-Driven cars provided by the OC (according to delegation size quota agreed between OC/FISU) or their own vehicles. If a delegation choose to use its own vehicle instead of the Self-Driven car assigned by OC, they will receive a daily allowance to cover usage of the vehicle and expenses (fuel, tolls, cleaning, etc.). OC might assist providing a contact list of local car rental that delegations can contact in case of need of a specific quotation. This last point is still under discussion and TBC.

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SUI	CER	Please consider the long travel, plus 2 hours before and the Ceremony. For some Aa that means up to 8 hours. Also, return to accommodation will be very late. We fear Aa in Sestrière for instance may not attend.	We aim to be as flexible as possible and may consider a slight delay for the arrival of athletes from the mountain clusters. However, we kindly request that delegations arrive at least 90 minutes before the ceremony to allow for adequate organization. We understand the importance of flexibility and will strive to ensure that everyone can fully enjoy this once-in-a-lifetime event. Our current plan is for delegations to arrive two hours before the ceremony, but we are open to potentially adjusting this timeframe for the mountain clusters. We will make every effort to accommodate varying arrival times.
FIN	ACR	Please notice that it's impossible to give any final numbers at the time of QE when the season has not even started in many sports.	We acknowledge the challenge of determining athlete numbers, especially when the season has not yet begun. In most cases this is still a challenge one month prior to the games. Therefore, there is the possibility to replace athletes (with athletes in the long list) following the athletes' replacement policy. However, it is important that delegations make minimal changes in the overall delegation numbers, as the organizing committee must make reservations and secure accommodations accordingly adjustments may be made, the delegation numbers are not sport-specific.
SUI	ACR	There might be less than 5 days stay. Why to pay 5 days?	Because at the time of the quantitative entry there are no travel dates requested. It is the same calculation for all participants of individual sports. After the Individual entries the invoice will be calculated taking into consideration arrival and departure days and the deposit already paid will be deducted for the final invoice.
JPN	ACR	We need to know where ACR MAC and mountains subcenters will be allocated and what services will be provided.	ACR MAC will be located in Torino, with two subcenters in Bardonecchia and Sestriere. All services will be available at the MAC, while the subcenters will offer ACR distribution and AND services.
JPN	ACR	ACR and Visa EES/ETIAS requirements: ETIAS starts later this year. Any support from OC for both administrative and financial	ETIAS travel authorization is an entry requirement for visa-exempt nationals traveling to any of the 30 European countries. Please note that ETIAS has been postponed until mid-2025, which means that Non Schengen

KOR	FIN	In Korea, budgets for games are typically allocated at the beginning of each new year. Considering this, is there a possibility that we pay the individual participation fee in January?	The OC has approved the payment timetable, which has implications on the cash flow, and therefore the budgeting. Any exceptions should be submitted individually for verification before eventual authorization.
CAN	SPT	Will there be a wax protocol for Biathlon and Cross Country?	We closely monitor the regulations and procedures of the concerned International Federations. The FISU Games are considered at Continental Cup level within FIS, therefore random checks may be conducted by FIS (as for other continental cup events). We will provide more information on this matter at the HoD meeting in September as well as in the technical handbooks. We strictly adhere to the rules set by the International Sport Federations, which prohibit the use of floor wax at our competitions.
SUI	TRA	Self driving: this cars are for free?	OC will provide free of charge Self-Driven cars to delegations following the principles of delegation size and defined by OC/FISU. If a delegation chooses to use its own vehicle instead of the Self-Driven car assigned by OC they will receive a daily allowance to cover usage of the vehicle and expenses (fuel, tolls, cleaning, etc.).
CAN	LOG	What is the assistance from OC for import and export of medication?	The OC will send the list of medications approved by the Italian Medicines Agency (AIFA). Any medical products imported into Italy will be the responsibility of the medical officer. In case delegations want to send medications/medial equipment to Italy prior the Games, OC will provide a list of logistics providers who can assist import and export shipping.

Please consider CIC process also to be set up and done at each accreditation point, not only at one central location. Thank you.	Yes, we consider that CIC process will be carried at the sub-accreditation centres of mountain clusters.
CHN	ACC	Thank you for the presentation. So the teams in Olimpia stay in university campus while for other teams will stay in hotels in FISU Games villages, right?	Olimpia is one of the university campuses hosting the athletes competing in Torino. The other university campus for the Torino cluster is Villa Claretta. The OC is currently working on defining the accommodation sites for each cluster (Bardonecchia, Sestriere, Pinerolo/Torre Pellice), and in the near future, all guests will receive comprehensive information and details.

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
