1	Welcome	Eder Leonz welcomes everyone and introduces the HoD Meeting.	
		Matthias Remund performs introductory speech and Ciro Sciretti does the roll call.

		Questions submitted in Q&A Form	
2	Questions submitted	Q (JPN): About village food menu: Can fruit juice and coffee be served also for lunch and dinner and not only in the morning? About fruits: some villages have bananas, apples, but not in all villages. Can the fruit types be more varied and consistent across the Villages?	
		A (Giuliano Muzzachi): We are taking notes of all requests and we have already started to change the level of food service.	
	Questions from Netherlands	Q (NED): Is it possible to write down the ingredients of meals and allergens so that people know exactly what is in their food? A (Giuliano Muzzachi): In the manuals the list of ingredients and allergens was present. We asked the hotels to provide those lists. Please tell us the places where this has not happened.	
		Follow-up (NED): could you please follow the time schedule as mentioned in the manual: there is a difference between those and the actual opening hours.A (Vincenzo Genovese): There's a difference in the small restaurants in mountain clusters, but it will be solved. In villages everything will be like in the HoD manuals.	
	Question from Japan	Q (JPN): Regarding medical rooms in Bardonecchia: depending on the location allocated for the space, the level of brightness is different from one place to another. The spaces for some delegations are very bright while others are too dark for office use. Please consider providing additional lights, such as desk lights, upon request. A (Vincenzo Genovese): We noted that, and we are already trying to solve the problem. Update from Vincenzo Genovese: brightness issue in Bardonecchia is now solved.	

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Question from Canada	Q (CAN): Could you please give us more details about the QR code for transportation? A (Enzo Calabrò): If you stay in Torino, the access to public transportation (bus, trams, metro) is free. On buses and trams you just have to show your accreditation. On metros: you need to use the QR code that you need to download on a daily basis because it expires at midnight. In Bardonecchia transportation is free. If you need to cross clusters: on the train from Porta Susa to Pinerolo and from Porta Nuova to Bardonecchia just show your accreditation. To Pragelato and Sestriere there are TC lines. Everything is on the transportation guide.
Question from Switzerland	Q (SUI): It was said yesterday in the HoD Meeting that the Offices and Medical Rooms would be finished today in Bardonecchia, but there is no furniture installed inside the offices already built. Athletes are arriving and some of them need to be treated. What are the solutions that you offer us? Can we help you organise our own offices? A (Rui Magalhães): We noted your question, and we'll try to provide service as soon as possible.
Questions from Czechia	 Q (CZE): Waxing cabins are too cold, please provide a solution soon. Rui Magalhães: About the heating, we need to study that. Q (CZE): The situation is not acceptable in some hotels because some rooms have temporary beds not only for the athletes but also for officials. In some cases, there are five people in the same room, some of which are sleeping on temporary beds. A (Vincenzo Genovese): I will speak with the director tomorrow
Question from Japan	morning and I will solve the situation. Q (JPN): We kindly request shuttle service TA-06 for tomorrow at least one return trip on Jan 11 for Open Training, while the TA- 06 is scheduled to start from Jan 12 the day after tomorrow. A (Ubaldo Prucker): I announce officially that tomorrow, due to bad weather conditions and heavy rain, there will be no unofficial training.

Follow-up question from Canada

Q (CAN): Where? A: (Ubaldo Prucker): In Pragelato, Ruà and Plan.

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Clarification from Jiho Kim (FISU)	Jiho Kim: For IHO M teams playing at 20:00 from tomorrow, please clarify where teams will have dinner. A (Giuliano Muzzachi): It depends on the team: they generally have dinner in the hotel. From tomorrow venues are open so dinner will be served at the venue. Delegations can contact F&B and DGS desks. Tomorrow at 1pm we will give you more information.
