	Question from Korea	<p>Q (KOR): Are there early departures?</p> <p>A (Enzo Calabrò): No, everybody leaves together.</p>	
	Reminder from the Head of Delegation Services	<p>Rui Magalhães: On Monday morning we will have a HoD Meeting about the Opening Ceremony, during which additional info will be given.</p>	
	Question from United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland	<p>Q (GBR): So early departures are not available (unless a bus is full), but athletes can still leave early on their own accord and use public transport to get home. Is that correct?</p> <p>A (Enzo Calabrò): Yes, you can use public transport to get home if you are staying in Torino, but please let us know if you do so, so that we don't wait for you with the buses provided by the OC.</p>	
	Questions from Australia	<p>Q (AUS): Can athletes arriving in Torino on 13th January use the transport buses for the opening ceremony as the shuttle to the hotels at conclusion of the ceremony?</p> <p>A (Enzo Calabrò): No, they need to be integrated in the transportation ceremony plan.</p> <p>Rui Magalhães: You can leave early but you have to take public transportation.</p>

Q (CAN): I believe the BTH training was moved to 12pm, is it possible to extend the breakfast which normally ends at 8:30am? Also, can you confirm transportation will leave early enough for technicians to get to the venue in the next few days. I believe it has not been consistent.

A (Rui Magalhães): As for breakfast, we need to get in touch with the hotel.

Enzo Calabrò: We cannot go to Pracatinat with big buses, only with small buses with 18 seats or mini vans (9 seats).

If the number of people is more of the capacity of the buses, some athletes need to wait for the buses to come back and pick them up. The ride will be approximately 1 hour and a half.

Ubaldo Prucker: If delegations have their own buses or vehicles, can we confirm that they can use them?

Enzo Calabrò: If they have VAPPs, yes, definitely.

Q (CHI): Where is the GTM (12-01)?
